Introduction to BKCF



BIMP-EAGA-ROK-Cooperation Fund

Established in 2021 by the Republic of Korea, BKCF promotes inclusive & balanced growth in the **Southeast Asia region and ASEAN Connectivity**. It also aims to support the **BIMP-EAGA's Vision 2025**.



Funded Projects

The Fund will provide grants for **individual member countries or subregional programs and projects**.

The **Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI)** has been designated as a fund depository and an operating entity of BKCF.



Priority sectors

Prioritization through consultations between BIMP-EAGA and the ROK
: (1) **Environment**, (2) **Tourism**, (3) **Connectivity**, and (4) **Agriculture & Fisheries**.



Project Process



Eligibility Requirements of Proponent

- Government agencies, public/private sector entities, research institutes, NGOs, and other autonomous institutes **from member countries of BIMP-EAGA and the ROK.**
- **Individuals are not eligible** to apply for the fund.


Grant Award Range

1- year Project	min 100,000 – max 500,000 USD
2-years Project	min 200,000 – max 500,000 USD
Multi-Country Project	max 250,000 USD per country



BKCF PROJECT OVERVIEW (1ST - 5TH)



Timeline for 6th BKCF Call




Submission: BKCF Portal



◆ From the BKCF 6th Call, the proponent must submit the proposal and required documents through the BKCF Portal (<https://www.gggi-bkcf.org>)

- Step 1: Access the **BKCF Portal** and click “Login”
- Step 2: Create a user account (for first time users)
- Step 3: Complete the online proposal form
- Step 4: Review and submit the proposal

The submission system will close at the **deadline (6 PM, March 27 KST)**. Proposals cannot be submitted after this time.

- Once all sections are completed, you can submit your proposal.
- After the final submission, you **cannot revise the proposal under any circumstances.**

Eligibility

- Both the **main proponent** and **partner organization** must be physically based registered in the BIMP countries or the Republic of Korea.

Proposal

- Budget **must be indicated in USD**.
- Review your proposal **thoroughly before submission**.
- Fill out the **Logical Framework before the Budget and Implementation Plan**, since the data is linked.
- **Save your draft frequently** before moving on to the next section.
- All contents of the Due Diligence section need to be filled.
- **All documents**, including supporting documents should be submitted in English.
